

“Flour Festival” - a Christian Year Cookbook

All churches have their good cooks, and Glyncorrwg church is no exception. Like many churches, Glyncorrwg's cooks have been preparing and serving good festive fare for very many years. This year, they are sharing their recipes with the wider world by way of a new cookbook, "Flour Festival", with recipes for the whole of the Christian year, from Advent to Harvest and Trinity.

Rosie Jones, who compiled the recipes, edited them and got them printed, has included a brief history of Glyncorrwg Church, pen pictures of the cooks, and a brief description of the culinary traditions of each church season. "The food served up by Glyncorrwg's cooks has always been amazing, with lots of variations (all improvements) on traditional recipes. Boiled fruit cake, snacks for cold carol singers, Whitsun teas with a difference, they're all in the book, and all with easy to follow instructions and lists of ingredients", says Rosie. Another feature of the book is that it's designed to be used in the kitchen, not left on the coffee table. Wire binding means it opens flat, glossy pages can stand being wiped clean, and there's enough white space on the page for you to write in your own notes and ideas.

The title of the book, "Flour Festival", is an appropriate one, as it's a celebration of the congregation's harvest of good cooking throughout the church year. The Flower Festival held in church this year brought it's own dividend in improved links to the school, some new choir members, and increased appreciation by the local community that the church was there for them, whether or not they came along every Sunday. Flour Festival, it is hoped, will do the same.

It's currently flying off the shelf within the congregation, at £7 a copy plus £1 post and packing, with all profits going back into the church.
